In September 2015, construction began on the most significant transformation since the inception of Cambridge Memorial Hospital in 1888. Now, nine months into construction, the new 240,000 square foot patient wing is truly beginning to take shape. With all five floors erected and the interior walls being placed to form the departments, we are closer than ever to the completion of this new wing!

WORK FOR A CURE SUPPORTS TRANSFORMATION CMH BY NAMING THE PAEDIATRIC WAITING ROOM

In 2013, Work for a Cure heard about the CMH Capital Redevelopment project and wanted to ensure that local families will have a comfortable and welcoming place in our new Paediatric department. They pledged \$250,000 to name our Paediatric Waiting Room that will be opening in 2017. We are so grateful that they recognized an amazing opportunity to help out, and went straight to work raising funds.

Work for a Cure is a not-for-profit organization dedicated to raising awareness and providing support for those affected by cancer. Run completely by volunteers, the vision of Work for a Cure is to 'give where they live' and ensure that no child in our community has to battle cancer alone. The hospital expansion was an excellent fit with their mission because we provide local care to families, and we serve many children and adults in our cancer support programs: Chemotherapy, Surgery, Diagnostics and Emergency.



Funds raised by Work for a Cure include several fun-filled and well-attended events, like their January Gala, Cancer Vanquish, Inside Ride, and Kevin Fanjoy Memorial Golf Tournament. They also make wishes come true for young cancer patients who would otherwise lose out on the joys of childhood.

Fundraising this kind of money through special events is a major accomplishment and can be a monumental task. When asked about the work that is involved, the committee responded, "We remain energized because we are confident that our volunteer efforts truly do make a local difference in the fight against cancer."

We congratulate Work for a Cure and their sponsors (*listed below*), partners, individuals and attendees who make these events possible. Remarkably, the committee was able to complete their pledge to CMH ahead of schedule! **Keep up the amazing work, our community thanks you.**
