100% of all hospital equipment is funded through the generosity of our community.

Thanks to the loyal support of our community, our 240,000 square foot new patient wing is now open.

This represents a 40% overall increase in the size of our hospital. The new wing includes the Emergency Department, Operating Rooms, Birthing Suites, Intensive Care Unit (ICU), Medicine, Mental Health, Paediatrics and Obstetrics.

We are currently entering Phase 3 in the development of our hospital. This is a 150,000 square foot renovation of the original building. The renovated wing includes Surgery, Rehab, Diagnostic Imaging and Laboratory.

Once fully renovated, we will increase from 143 to 197 beds and 80% of the rooms will be private, providing more infection control and comfort for patients.
