New and replacement equipment is needed to provide support and comfort throughout the patient journey. Essential items help patients get where they need to go, bring services to the bedside, and monitor how patients are doing.

All equipment is purchased with the generous support of our Community.



In the next 3 years Cambridge Memorial Hospital will need \$4 million to purchase new and replacement equipment to maintain and enhance patient comfort and care.

Items like stretchers, treatment chairs, vital signs monitors, portable x-ray units, and replacement beds, including specialized birthing beds, empower our healthcare team and ensure patients are comfortable during procedures and stays at our Hospital.

Simply put, these items allow patients to get where they need to go, bring services to the bedside, help monitor how patients are doing, and provide support throughout the patient journey.

Over the next 3 years, the hospital will need \$4 million worth of replacement equipment that contributes to care day in and day out at Cambridge Memorial Hospital. Upgrading and replacing essential items for patient comfort is ongoing and critical to providing the very best care at our Community Hospital.

With your on-going investment in priority equipment needs, we provide our Hospital with funds to purchase the equipment needed to support patient comfort and care.
